History and Heritage

The Teleo University story began in **1991** when T-Net was founded by Bill Hull, a pastor committed to returning his church and others to their disciple making roots. T-Net is an interdenominational ministry **committed** to coaching pastors and church leaders to **finish** the Great Commission in their congregations, regions, and in every country of the world. Finishing the Great Commission in every country of the world so that no nation is unreached is what we call **PROJECT ZERO** because the mandate of "all nations" or "all ethnos" ends at ZERO.

After years of partnering with Christian colleges and seminaries to grant degrees, T-Net founded Teleo University to serve the thousands of pastors completing T-Net's Theological Education by Extension in dozens of countries in Africa, Asia, and the Americas. T-Net and Teleo University seek to finish the Great Commission in every nation through the **Project Zero** initiative. T-Net will continue to train international pastors to multiply disciple making churches. And Teleo University will offer online distance education and degrees that are built upon T-Net's rigorous training program. We follow the principle found in 2 Timothy 2:2, "Teach faithful men who can teach others also" until the Great Commission is finished...**Because the Mandate ENDS AT ZERO.**

Teleo University Distinctives

Teleo University plays a unique role in global Theological Education. Teleo University's focus is on *Finishing* the Great Commission of Jesus (Matthew 28:19-20) in each nation of the world by empowering indigenous pastors and church leaders. Teleo University only seeks students who are currently pastors, church planters, or key lay leaders who are members of the T-Net global network of disciple makers. These Christian leaders do not need to leave their ministries and families to attend classes. Teleo University offers no resident campus learning. Instead, students must remain in a local church ministry to implement what they learn in this unique online distance education program.

Teleo University professors share their knowledge with students through cross-culturally tested curriculum. Students meet their professors through the printed curriculum and online courses which empowers our students to receive practical theological education while continuing to serve in their local church ministry.

By gathering students into study groups called T-Net Training Centers, students benefit from pastoral care, fellowship, and collaboration with fellow students, and peer mentoring from those who have studied and applied this curriculum in their ministries. Furthermore, the online courses and Teleo University digital library offers access to more resources.
